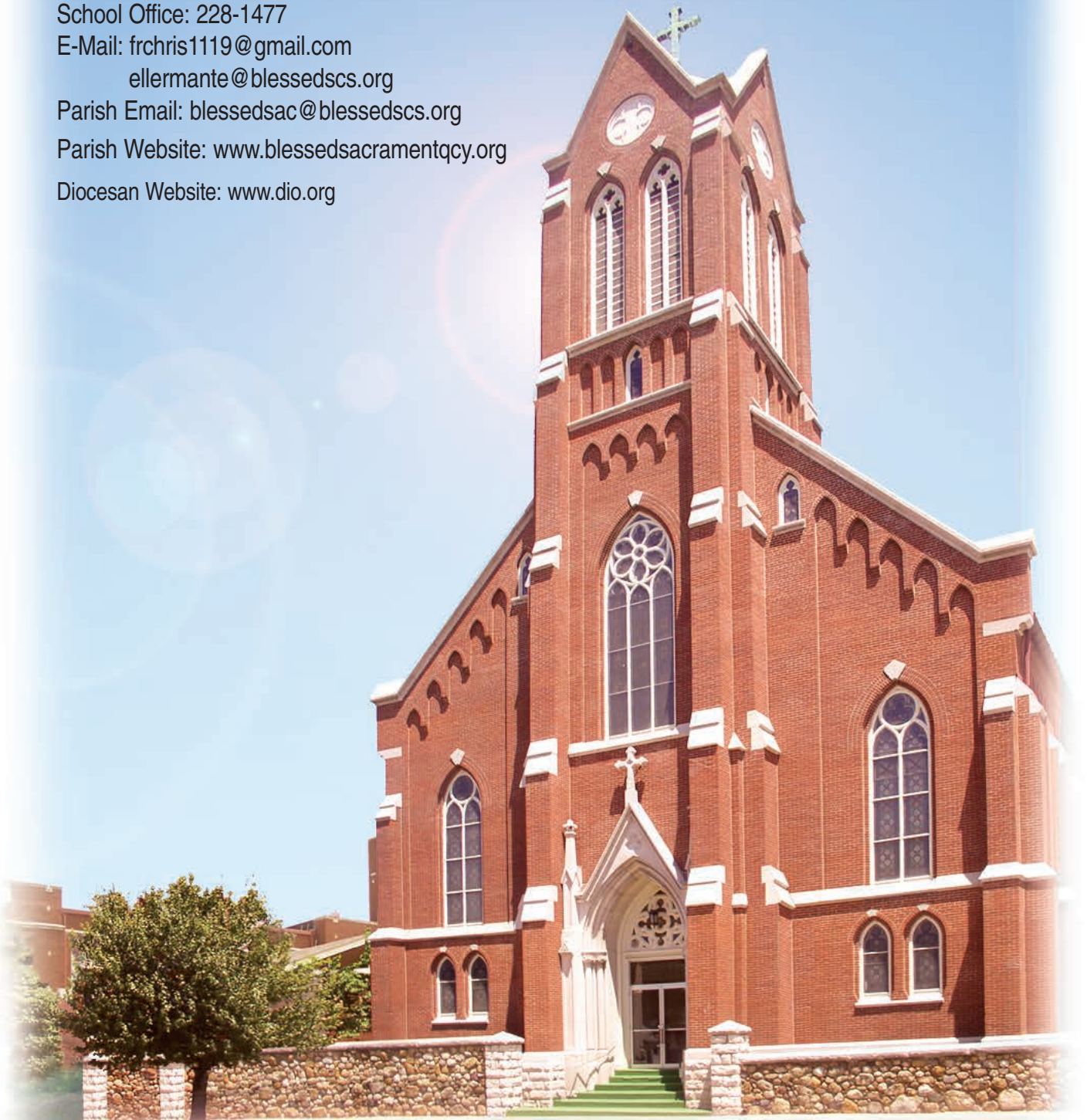

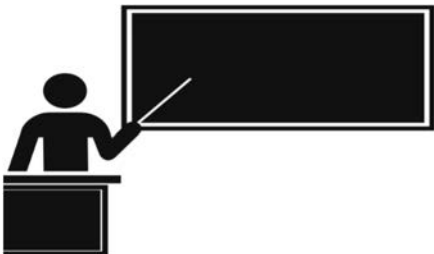

School News

QCES Curriculum Mapping

During October and November, the Quincy Catholic Elementary School teachers began working together to create a common, standards aligned science curriculum. The teachers from Blessed Sacrament, St. Francis, St. Dominic, and St. Peter Schools have participated in half day meetings with their grade level colleagues to discuss what is being taught in science as well as analyzed how each topic in their content aligns to Next Generation Science Standards. At the conclusion of each session, the grade level teams collaboratively agreed on what science units all four schools will teach. Throughout this opportunity, teachers have not only able to create horizontal alignment in science for the four schools at each grade level, but have also developed important, collaborative relationships with other Catholic school teachers in Quincy! We continue to be very grateful to the Tracy Family Foundation for fiscally supporting this professional development opportunity and education consultant Elizabeth Brown for leading us in this process.
