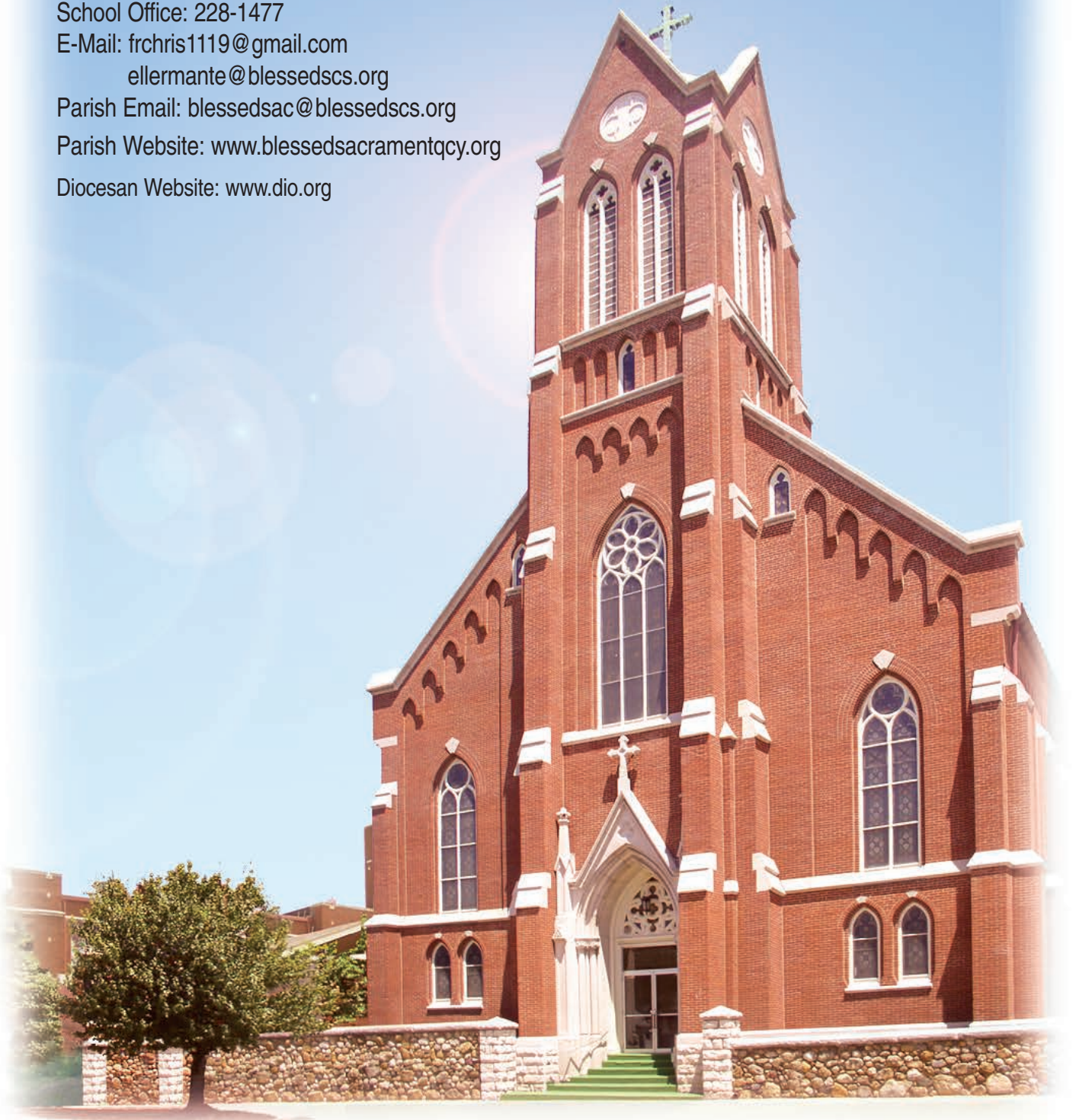

There will be 74 prizes given away in all, totaling \$167,750.
