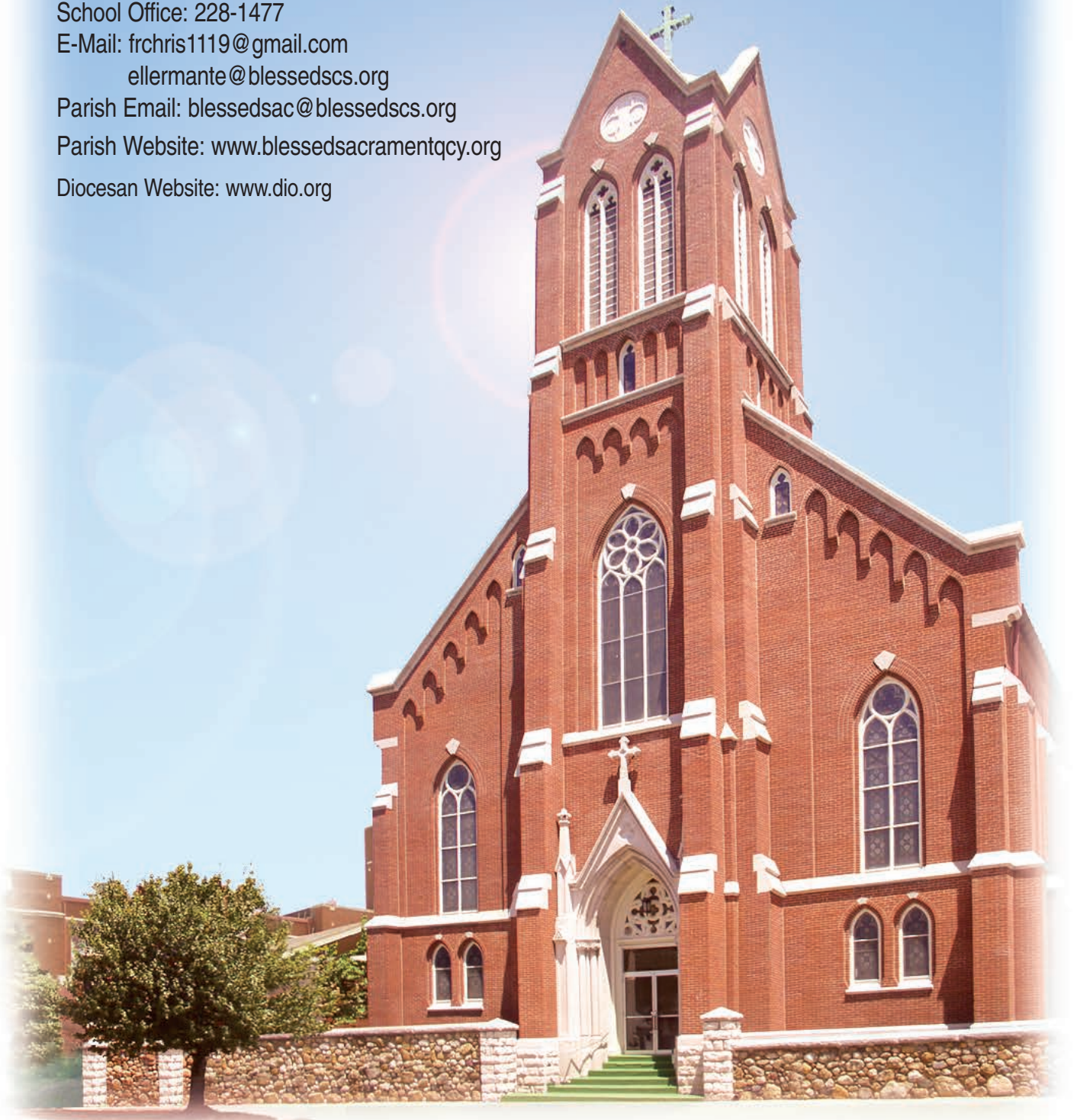

## MEGA RAFFLE TICKET SALES
