**All About Lent**



Lamb of God ~ "Agnus Dei" As you may have noticed, during Lent we have been singing the Lamb of God in Latin. The usage of Latin in the liturgy is a long-standing tradition as Latin is still the official language of the Church. One of the great blessings of knowing some of the Mass parts in Latin is that whenever you might travel, you could still participate in singing certain parts of the Mass, even though you may not know the language of the country.

**Come to Confession** — Due to the ongoing nature of the pandemic, most parishes within the Archdiocese are not having Penance services. However, during Lent, confession will be available in the churches throughout the Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas on Wednesdays from 6:00-7:00 p.m. Accommodations have been made to ensure social distancing. We also have a regular Wednesday morning Confession time as well as the Saturday time slot.

**Stations of the Cross** are on the Fridays of Lent, at 7:00 p.m. All are encouraged to follow the way of Jesus to Calvary. They last about half an hour.

**Operation Rice Bowl:** Rice bowls are available throughout Lent in the entrances to the church.
