Confession and/or Anointing of the Sick Before Hospitalizations

~ If you know you are going to be admitted to the hospital for surgery, please inform Father Bruce prior to hospitalization and ask for the Sacrament of Reconciliation and/or the Anointing of the Sick. This is a great opportunity for parishioners to receive these sacraments in light of the ongoing pastoral and sacramental relationship that already exists between them and their pastor. Hospital priest chaplains make it their priority to ensure the "Sacrament of the Sick" is offered to Catholic patients, especially when in danger of death. So, please contact Father if you know you will be hospitalized in the near future, and let him know you would like to receive these sacraments before your hospitalization. Or, if you are taken to the hospital unexpectedly, let the hospital staff know that you are catholic and would like them to contact the Catholic chaplain on call.
