“How do I or one of my friends look into becoming Catholic?” What a great question! The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (R.C.I.A.) is the process. The first weeks are used to cover basic elements of the faith. The second phase is delving more deeply into the teachings of the Catholic Church. The third phase is immediate preparation for becoming Catholic. The last phase is a period of processing what happened at the Easter Vigil and where we go from here as newly-initiated Catholics. There is no commitment to become Catholic until the Easter Vigil. So don’t feel like you will be pressured, if you either just want to learn more or are still trying to make a final decision. The sessions will start toward the middle of September. Confession and/or Anointing of the Sick Before Hospitalizations

~ If you know you are going to be admitted to the hospital for surgery, please inform Father Bruce prior to hospitalization and ask for the Sacrament of Reconciliation and/or the Anointing of the Sick. Hospital priest chaplains make it their priority to ensure the "Sacrament of the Sick" is offered to Catholic patients, especially when in danger of death. So, please contact Father if you know you will be hospitalized in the near future, and let him know you would like to receive these sacraments before your hospitalization. Or, if you are taken to the hospital unexpectedly, let the hospital staff know that you are Catholic and would like them to contact the Catholic chaplain on call.
