BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on either the first or second Sunday of the month at St. Anthony Parish and St. Mary Parish respectively when Fr. H is celebrating Mass. Parent(s) who plan to have their child baptized are required to be practicing their Catholic faith, be registered and active in the parish for no less than six months prior to the baptism. First time parent(s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the parish office, during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

COVID Restrictions Lifted

Effective on July 1, Bishop Kemme has lifted the previous guidelines and restrictions for the Diocese of Wichita pertaining to the pandemic, with the exception of the distribution of Communion under both forms. I would like to quote two statements in his correspondence to us that I will address as well.

"While these restrictions will no longer be in force across the diocese, it is important to know that some of our people may likely be challenged by this decision. As pastors, I believe we should be sensitive to their concerns and respond as appropriately as we can." With that being said, I intend to leave the social distance seating sections of our church in place until further notice.

The second quote: "I leave it to the discretion of each pastor to determine if or when to reinstate the offering of the sign of peace, which is optional in the liturgy." I will provide specific direction about this during the Masses myself.

Additionally, once again as I have said in previous bulletins, I would ask if you are sick or ill that you refrain from coming to confession in the confessionals until you are well.

If you know of someone in our parish such as a spouse, etc. that is expressing interest in the possibility of becoming Catholic, please have them call me as soon as possible that we may begin that process for them, as it is that time of year again.

Altar Server Training

I will be training new and existing servers on Saturday morning, July 10.
