## Pray, Hope, Don't Worry

This week we celebrate the feast day of St. Pio of Pietrelcina (Padre Pio), the famous 20th Century stigmatist and mystic. He has gained a lot of attention because of the miracles that he worked, as well as the prophetic words that he uttered. For today, though, I'd like to focus on one of his great proverbs: Pray, Hope, Don't Worry. It matches up so well with the messages from other saints of the 20th Century! We have a responsibility as Catholic Christians to turn to the Lord in prayer for our own needs and for those of the whole world...but we should always do so with *great confidence*. The essence of the theological virtue of hope is the conviction that the Lord is at work in every situation. In the darkest of hours, He is present, and through us, He wants to be even more present. So, in the craziness of this period of life, as Christians, we *must prioritize our prayer life, AND we must pray with confidence that the Lord is acting and will continue to act*. If this is difficult, then pray for confidence! The Lord wants to be loved and trusted, and He will help to make that happen!
