You Have Your Own Identity

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus heals the sight of Bartimaeus – the son of Timaeus. The man's name literally means "the son of Timaeus." How sad! It's almost as if he had no identity of his own...or if he did, his identity revolved around his disability! Sometimes that can happen to us. We can be identified by others with our family...or with a disability we have...or with a particular job we currently have...or by a sin we committed. We are reminded by Our God that He has created each of us intentionally, that we have each been given a particular vocation, and that there is nothing generic about us. Pope John Paul II reminds us: "We are not the sum of our weaknesses and failures; we are the sum of the Father's love for us and our real capacity to become the image of His Son Jesus." So, remember: you have your own identity in Christ. Live that identity and rejoice in it!
