## **BAPTISMS**

First time parent(s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the parish office, during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

**January 30, Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time: Jer 1:4-5, 17-19 / 1 Cor 12:31-13:13 / Lk 4:21-30**
