## Living Out Our Anointing

In this Sunday's Gospel we hear Jesus applying to Himself the words of the prophet Isaiah: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me." Here's the thing: as Jesus applies these words to Himself, He also applies them to us. As He does so, He greatly expands our vocation as Christians. To be sure, there are certain parts of our lives that are pretty simple: pray and follow the Commandments. When the anointing of the Holy Spirit is considered, however, our lives get a lot more interesting...and even complicated! In Christ we have been anointed with the Holy Spirit to "bring glad tidings to the poor, to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind," and that can get pretty messy. Don't let the messiness deter you from living out the gift of the Holy Spirit that has been given to you. There are many in our world who need us to live as the Lord's anointed, and the Lord has given us the gift of His Holy Spirit for their sake.
