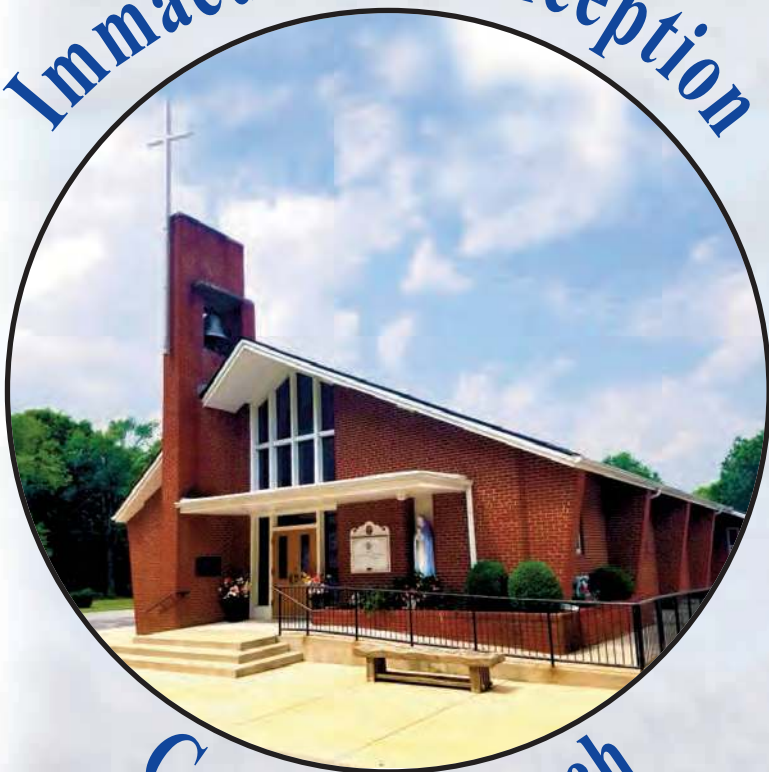

If you find yourself in any of the following situations: you are living in a marriage that has not been blessed by the Church OR cohabitating (living as husband and wife without being actually married in the church) OR you are in need of an annulment in order to have a present marriage convalidated OR are divorced and want to be able to start dating someone, please contact Fr. Most of these situations will render a person unable to go to Communion and/or Confession OR to function as Godparents for Baptism and/or Sponsors for Confirmation. He will assist you with any of the above situations so that you will be able to start receiving Holy Communion again and/or are free to pursue a dating relationship with someone, if you so choose.
