# Fr. Tom's Column

Today we celebrate the 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time. In the gospel story today Jesus initiates the miraculous catch of fish. The disciples had been fishing all night long and had

caught nothing. Jesus encourages them, "Put out into deep water." When we are challenged to find "a catch" in our own everyday lives, we try to find solutions that go deeper to the root of our problems. Simple solutions without depth catch very little.

This Sunday at our 10:00 a.m. Mass we celebrate Boy Scout Sunday. The Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts of our parish will be leading the liturgical ministries at our 10 a.m. Mass. I would like to thank our Boy Scout parish liaison Kelly Baker and our Scoutmaster Duke Collins for their fine work in leading our scouting groups. I very much recommend participation in our parish Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts programs.

Next Sunday we will celebrate the Rite of Acceptance and Welcome for our RCIA members who have been journeying with us in anticipation of joining or completing initiation in the Catholic faith. The Rite of Acceptance is for the unbaptized who officially enter the catechumenate in this ritual and become catechumens. The Rite of Welcome is for 2 groups: (1) those already baptized in another Christian tradition, and (2) those Catholics who have not been catechized beyond the sacrament of Baptism. At next Sunday's 10:00 a.m. Mass we will celebrate this combined Rite of Acceptance and Welcome.


