BAPTISMS

First time parent(s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the parish office, during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

Do not schedule, commit to, or make down payments for venues, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. until you have met with the Pastor. February 13, Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time: Jer 17:5-8 / 1 Cor 15:12, 16-20 / Lk 6: 17, 20-26
