BAPTISMS

Parent(s) who plan to have their child baptized are required to be practicing their Catholic faith, be registered and active in the parish for no less than six months prior to the baptism. First time parent(s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the parish office, during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

Dates for weddings will only be scheduled after meeting with the Pastor. Do not schedule, commit to, or make down payments for venues, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. until you have met with the Pastor. There is no guarantee to scheduling a wedding on your preferred day.

February 27, Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time: Sir 27:4-7 / 1 Cor 15:54-58 / Lk 6:39-45
It is said, "Preach the Gospel at all times. Use words if necessary." While there is some debate over who said these words, it doesn't really matter. The point is, in our discipleship, our actions certainly preach louder than our words. In fact, it may be best if we don't open our mouths at all! Today's reading from Sirach certainly suggests this truth: "One's faults [appear] when one speaks." What if Jesus never spoke a word? Would people have gotten His message of love by simply watching His actions? The obvious answer is yes! But what about you and me? Would people recognize our Christian discipleship by simply watching our actions? And what about when we do speak? Do our words align with our professed love for Jesus, or do they more often cause our faults to appear? Here is something to reflect upon this week!
