FROM THE RECTOR – Sexagesima Sunday

During the season of Septuagesima, the Church sets before us for contemplation Adam, Noah and Abraham, Old Testament figures who are intimately involved in salvation history. Noah's fidelity to the Lord and obedience to the will of the Father along with his constancy during the flood are a foreshadowing of the coming of the salvific work of Christ and the response that we should have to Our Savior and what He accomplishes for us. Like Noah we are called to fidelity and obedience; so too, fidelity and obedience are fruits of the cleansing waters of baptism that Christ provides for His chosen ones. If the ark saved the world at one time, the wood of the cross has saved the whole world for all time. The perfect response to the saving waters of baptism is the life of humble service to Our Lord; we must decrease in order that Christ might increase in us. As we continue to prepare for Lent and strive to root out sin and grow in holiness, let us give particular attention to fidelity and obedience as necessary virtues in our spiritual growth. Let us listen attentively to St. Paul's exhortation to the Corinthians and find our strength in suffering and glorify the Lord through our sacrifices.

THE LENTEN SEASON

The season of Septuagesima begins on Sunday, 13 February 2022 and provides us with the opportunity to better prepare ourselves for our Lenten Season which begins on Ash Wednesday, 2 March 2022. In order to spiritually assist the faithful of the Oratory during the Lenten season there will be additional opportunities for both confession and the celebration of the Holy Mass.

During Lent, in addition to the times already published, <u>Confessions</u> will be heard from 11:15 am until 12:45 pm on Tuesdays and Thursdays (beginning Thursday, 3 March 2022).

We will also have the opportunity for <u>Eucharistic Adoration</u> on the following days and times (beginning Thursday, 3 March 2022):
