BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10:00 a.m. Mass on either the first or second Sunday of the month at St. Anthony Parish and St. Mary Parish respectively when Fr. H Setter is celebrating Mass. Parent(s) who plan to have their child baptized are required to be actively practicing their Catholic faith, be registered and active in the parish for no less than six months prior to the baptism. First time parent(s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the parish office, during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

MARRIAGES

The bride or groom must be registered in the parish for a minimum of six months before preparation for marriage will begin. The bride or groom registered in the parish is expected to be actively participating in the life of the Church by living the Stewardship Way of Life. Please contact the Pastor to begin. Dates for the weddings will only be scheduled **AFTER** meeting with the Pastor. Do not schedule, commit to, or make down payments for venues, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. until you have met with the Pastor. There is no guarantee to scheduling a wedding on your preferred day.

Second Sunday of Lent - March 13: Gen 15:5-12, 17-18 / Phil 3:20-4:1 / Lk 9:28B-36

Perhaps we may find it odd that the Apostles did not always seem to be aware of exactly who Jesus was. In fact, it took some time for most of them to recognize that Jesus was more than just an inspired rabbi. In time, Peter would be the first to profess that Jesus was the Christ, the Living Son of God made man. And yet, he still didn't always get it. In today's Gospel, after Peter sees Jesus transfigured and conversing with Moses and Elijah, his initial reaction is that they should put up three tents, symbolic of his temporal nature in this temporal world. This suggestion seems to be at odds with Peter's own profession just a few days earlier that Jesus is the Christ. It would not be the last time that Peter would stumble in his recognition of the Divinity of Jesus, and yet, Jesus would entrust him with the keys to the Church! Let us also remember all we have been entrusted with! Our Lord trusts us, like Peter, to be stewards of His church and of one another. He wishes to use our discipleship to transform us from the ordinary to the extraordinary, from the temporal to the eternal.
