



The Parable of the Prodigal Son - Who Are You?

In this Sunday's parable, we hear Jesus speaking about the Prodigal Son and how his father, with great mercy, welcomed him back home. It's an amazing reminder of the mercy of the Lord! At the same time, it provides us with the opportunity to ask ourselves: with whom do I most identify in this parable? Am I in need of mercy like the prodigal son? Am I in a position to give mercy like the father? OR (and this is a tough one) am I like the older son, who has a hard time welcoming his brother home? Every parable offers us an opportunity to place ourselves in the role of one of the characters in that parable, but this parable offers a particular challenge to see in what way each of us needs conversion. So, again, for you: with whom do you most identify in this parable?


