When Father Noone is not conducting parish missions and days of recollection, he's involved with an outreach in Haiti, which paved the way for Father Noone preaching for Unbound. Father Noone believes we all have the same ministry: to realize we are God's instruments, through which He accesses others' lives, and enters ours through theirs.
