meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

**ABSTINENCE:** Refrain from eating meat

#### WHO NEEDS TO FAST & ABSTAIN?

FAST: Ages 18-59 ABSTAIN: 14 and older

**ON THE EUCHARIST** ~ Join hundreds of friends and journey with us as we unpack the USCCB document *The Mystery of the Eucharist in the Life of the Church*.
