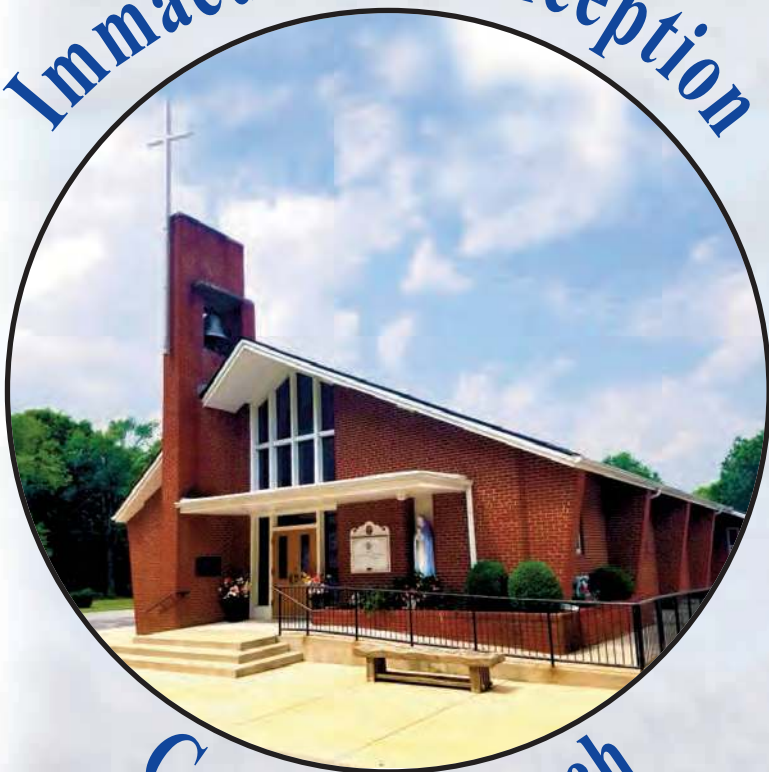

**FASTING & ABSTAINING DURING LENT****WHEN DO WE DO THIS?**

FAST & ABSTAIN: Ash Wednesday & Good Friday

ABSTAIN: All Fridays during Lent

WHAT DOES THAT MEAN?

FASTING: Eating one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

ABSTINENCE: Refrain from eating meat

WHO NEEDS TO FAST & ABSTAIN?

FAST: Ages 18-59

ABSTAIN: 14 and older

~ Join hundreds of friends and journey with us as we unpack the USCCB document *The Mystery of the Eucharist in the Life of the Church*.
