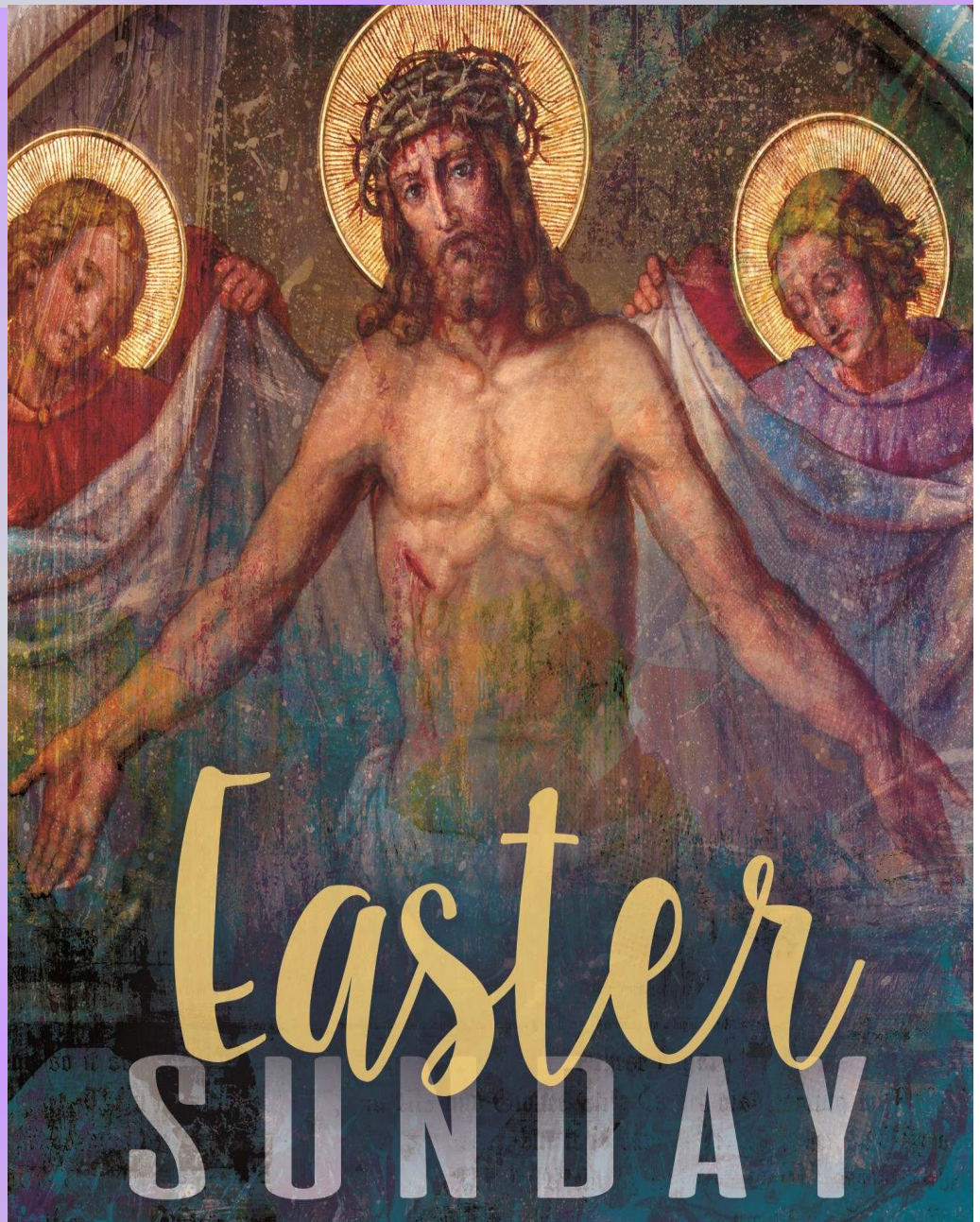

BAPTISMS	MARRIAGES
Baptisms are celebrated after the 10:00 a.m. Mass on either the first or second Sunday of the month at St. Anthony Parish and St. Mary Parish respectively when Fr. H. Setter is celebrating Mass. Parent(s) who plan to have their child baptized are required to be actively practicing their Catholic faith and be registered and active in the parish for no less than six months prior to the baptism. First time parent(s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the Parish Office during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.	The bride or groom must be registered in the parish for a minimum of six months before preparation for marriage will begin. The bride or groom registered in the parish is expected to be actively participating in the life of the Church by living the Stewardship Way of Life. Please contact the Pastor to begin. Dates for the weddings will only be scheduled <u>AFTER</u> meeting with the Pastor. Do not schedule, commit to, or make down payments for venues, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. until you have met with the Pastor. There is no guarantee to scheduling a wedding on your preferred day.

Easter Sunday, The Resurrection of the Lord - April 17
Acts 10:34a, 37-43 / Ps 118:1-2, 16-17, 22-23 / Col 3:1-4 / Jn 20:1-9

Poor Peter. What a week. Followed Jesus for three years. Chased Him across a sea and sank. Gave up his fishing gig just when he caught the motherload. Fell asleep in Gethsemane. Said goodbye to Jesus by pretending he didn't even know Him — not once, but three times. Watches Jesus die, be buried, and then disappear. Poor Peter. Yet, who does Mary of Magdala run to when she finds the tomb empty: Peter. Despite all of Peter's frailties and inadequacies, Peter is the go-to guy. Why? Apparently, the other disciples saw what Jesus saw, a rock. Not the rock that guarded an empty tomb, but the rock that would guard and defend the truth, even unto death. What kind of rocks are we?
