BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10:00 a.m. Mass on either the first or second Sunday of the month at St. Anthony Parish and St. Mary Parish respectively when Fr. H. Setter is celebrating Mass. Parent(s) who plan to have their child baptized are required to be actively practicing their Catholic faith, and be registered and active in the parish for no less than six months prior to the baptism. First time parent(s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the Parish Office, during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

MARRIAGES

The bride or groom must be registered in the parish for a minimum of six months before preparation for marriage will begin. The bride or groom registered in the parish is expected to be actively participating in the life of the Church by living the Stewardship Way of Life. Please contact the Pastor to begin. Dates for the weddings will only be scheduled AFTER meeting with the Pastor. Do not schedule, commit to, or make down payments for venues, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. until you have met with the Pastor. There is no guarantee to scheduling a wedding on your preferred day.

Fifth Sunday of Lent, April 3 - Isaiah 43:16-21 / Phil 3:8-14 / John 8:1-11

"Praise Be Jesus Christ!" This was the greeting you would receive from the Discalced Carmelites that lived in our diocese not long ago, whether in writing, in person, or over the phone. Coming from a nun, it doesn't sound so surprising, but what if it came from your tongue? From the tongue of every believer? I'd bet the devil would be beside himself! People might even wonder why you would even say such a thing. Why would you say such a thing? Could you say such a thing? Give an answer as to why you believe, as we profess in the Nicene Creed every Sunday, "in one Lord Jesus Christ"? In today's Gospel, a woman is allegedly caught in the very act of adultery, and will be stoned to death, according to the law of Moses. Talk about despair! Fortunately, the Pharisees did something right, unknowingly, and brought the woman to the only judge in all of creation that can weigh the heart perfectly. Isaiah, in the first reading exhorts, "See, I am doing something new!" The Pharisees escort the woman in with the old law, and Jesus "springs forth" with the new law, mercy! There is a good chance she wants to know who just saved her from certain death. Guess what? Jesus did the same thing for you and me, and together with the woman, we are "Given" new life, and can proclaim — "Praise Be Jesus Christ!"
