Today we celebrate the **4th Sunday of Easter**. We call this day "Good Shepherd Sunday." In the Gospel Jesus says, "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me." Our membership in Christ's sheepfold entails: (1) hearing Christ's voice, and (2) following that voice. May we continue to attune our ears to the voice of our Shepherd, and rise to the challenges of discipleship.

Today at 10:00 a.m. Mass we celebrate with RCIA Candidate Dylan Jenkins, the **Rite of Reception into the Full Communion of the Catholic Church**. In this rite, Dylan will receive the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist that will lead him into Full Communion of the Catholic Church. Our parish is very excited for Dylan's journey that has led him to this important sacramental moment. And we joyfully anticipate his next sacrament he will celebrate next weekend with his fiancé Haley as they enter the sacrament of Matrimony.

From the Pastor's Desk

During the Easter season, Blessed Sacrament Parish will be showing a 5-session set of 1-hour liturgical videos entitled *The Art of Celebrating the Mass*. Produced by the Mundelein Liturgical Institute and presented by Fr. Dennis Gill, these videos give an in-depth look into the theological and liturgical meaning of the Mass. We now want to make this content available to the entire parish community during this very appropriate time of the Easter Season when we especially reflect on the presence of the Risen Christ in the Eucharist. Each of the weekly videos will be shown at three different dates and times each week:

Thursday evenings, 6:00-7:30 p.m. – Lower Level

Week 5: May 17-19: Communion Rite & Concluding Rites of the Mass

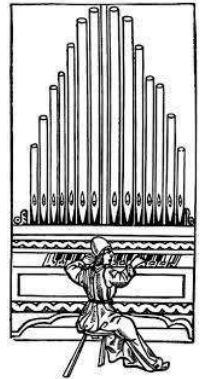
