#### BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10:00 a.m. Mass on either the first or second Sunday of the month at St. Anthony Parish and St. Mary Parish respectively when Fr. H. Setter is celebrating Mass. First time parent(s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the Parish Office during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

The bride or groom registered in the parish is expected to be actively participating in the life of the Church by living the Stewardship Way of Life. Please contact the Pastor to begin. Dates for the weddings will only be scheduled AFTER meeting with the Pastor. Do not schedule, commit to, or make down payments for venues, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. until you have met with the Pastor. There is no quarantee to scheduling a wedding on your preferred day.


#### FROM FATHER H

#### May 22, Sixth Sunday of Easter: Acts 15:1-2, 22-29 / Ps 67:2-3, 5, 6, 8 / Rev 21:10-14, 22-23 / Jn 14:23-29

Happy Easter! Occasionally, our faith will be challenged and our peace disturbed by something we witness or hear. Have you ever experienced a "controlled burn"? Here in Kansas, it is a common occurrence. It could be a pile of wood, an acre, or hundreds of acres. It is a sight to see and the heat it produces can be overwhelming. It is just so powerful! Then, it happens. A flame or ember gets away. The next thing you know, it isn't a controlled burn. Peace quickly escapes with the roque fire. In today's first reading, the early Church was confronted with one of those roque fires — "Unless you are circumcised according to the Mosaic practice, you cannot be saved." What resulted was the Council of Jerusalem. Sometimes, it is necessary to fight fire with fire. The fire of the Holy Spirit can move quickly, too, and did back then, as it does in our time. Discussion ensued and blossomed into Church teaching. When the peace of Christ escapes you, remember what our Lord said, "Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid." God is always in control, even when the fire gets away.
