Lifting ALL of Us Up to Heaven

I think that the biggest temptation from the Solemnity of the Ascension is to think of it as Jesus' disappearance from the earth. He dies, He rises, and then (it seems) He disappears. The reality is a bit different, but we need to think about the Ascension from a different perspective. We need first to remember that by His death and Resurrection (and our Baptisms), Jesus has now united us to His Body; He is the head, and we are the members. We need also to remember that as Jesus returns to the place from which He came, He brings with Him something He didn't have previously: a body - Resurrected and Mystical. As Jesus goes to His place by the Father, then, in some way, He brings us with Him. So, on this celebration of the Ascension, remember that this is not just a celebration for Jesus but a pre-celebration for all of us. He lifts all of us with Him and begins a journey that will be completed in our own Resurrections on the Last Day.
