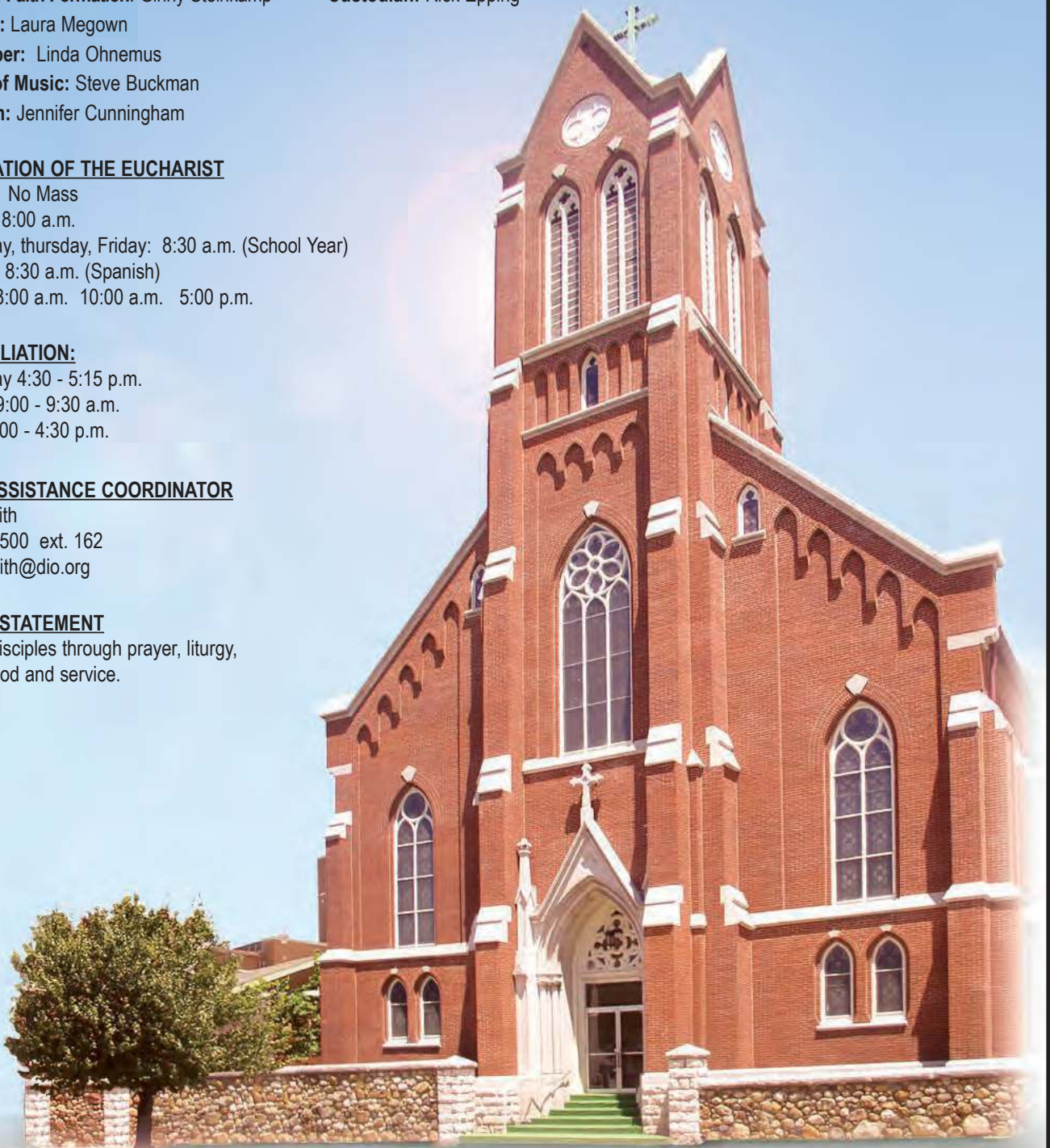

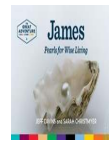

Unfortunately, that tan could come with a cost. According to skincancer.org, 1 in 5 people will develop skin cancer by age 70 and that 2 people die from melanoma every hour.
