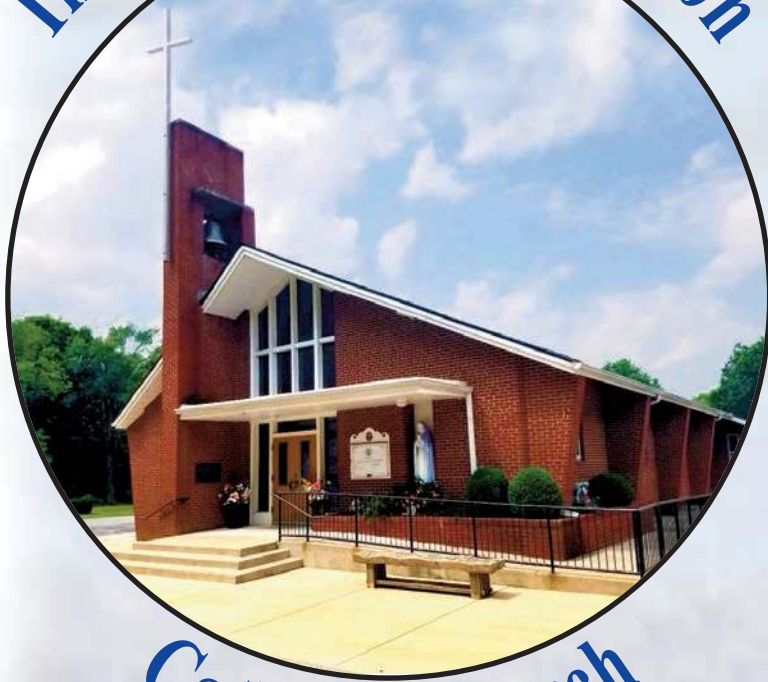

Corpus Christi Observance ~ As the Church helps us to focus our attention on the great gift of the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus, the Corpus Christi, present in the Blessed Sacrament, we will observe a couple of minutes of Adoration right after Communion. We will end the Mass with Benediction. Normally, the priest blesses the people through his words. Today, the priest says nothing because the blessing comes from Jesus Himself, present in the Blessed Sacrament.
