## FROM THE RECTOR – Second Sunday after Pentecost/External Solemnity of Corpus Christi

In the Holy Gospel for today the Lord speaks about a wedding banquet, an image of the Eucharistic sacrifice into which we are all invited. Sadly, as the parable indicates, a great many people refuse the Lord's invitation and reject a place at the table of God. There should be profound sadness at the ease with which men neglect or ignore the blessings and bounty of God. However, the Gospel along with the celebration of Corpus Christi provide the opportunity to meditate upon the gift of our Eucharistic Lord and the dedication needed to make ourselves worthy recipients of such a great gift. We must root out any disposition that would have us reject the true and abiding presence of the Lord. Likewise, we must resolve to spend time with Him in gratitude for the blessings received and with the desire to deepen the intimacy that He has forged with us in His blood. Our Catholic faith in the Eucharist sets us apart from the rest of the world; and like the Lord's cross, the Eucharist is a stumbling block for many who refuse to humbly submit to God's plan for salvation. For those of us who do believe, the Most Holy Eucharist is the living source of our hope and confidence in the Lord. Let us rejoice and give thanks that we have been found worthy not only to be invited to the Lord's banquet but also to take our place at His table.

### THE HOUR OF TERCE

The hour of Terce in the Divine Office is assigned to be sung before the principal Mass of the day when that Mass is sung in choir. For the last year or so, the schola has been chanting this Hour of the Divine Office before the principal Mass on Sundays and major feasts in the Saint Joseph's Room. The resumption and frequency of coffee hours and other events made it difficult for others to join the schola for that hour. In the last several months, the Schola began singing Terce in the church approximately 20 minutes before Mass. If you are interested in participating, you can follow along on your smartphone using your browser to go to the divinumofficium.com website. From the rubric's options, choose 'Divino Afflatu' and also choose your translation language of choice in the settings. Then you can find Terce of the day as the schola sings it. Also, there is a smartphone app called 'BrevMeum' that draws down the Office of the day from that same website. If you get that app and download each week's Offices, you can follow from there as well. You can also print the information and bring it with you if you prefer to leave your phone in the car. Everyone is encouraged to participate in this hour of the Divine Office and allow this ancient prayer to assist you in preparing for Holy Mass.

#### **DURING THE SUMMER MONTHS**

## SCHEDULING BAPTISMS

The Oratory is blessed with a growing community that is evident by the increased number of baptisms. Given that the Oratory shares the space with St. Luke the Evangelist along with the other liturgical rites celebrated by the Oratory itself, it is prudent to schedule baptisms on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturdays of the month beginning at 10 am.
