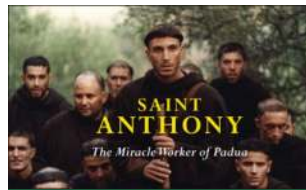

Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession - As we celebrate the Year of the Eucharist, we will have a Eucharistic Procession on the Sunday of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, June 19. We will begin at 11:30 a.m. after the 10:00 a.m. Mass. We will process out of the church, around the hall parking lot into Biermann Street to Avenue B to Main Street, then back into the church. After a few minutes of adoration, we will conclude with Benediction. I have scheduled this event for 11:30 a.m. so people who do and do not want to attend the 10:00 a.m. Mass can all participate. As the Eucharist is at the center of our lives as Catholic Christians, I would strongly encourage as many as possible to participate in this beautiful expression of our love and belief in the Eucharist.

Our 40 hours will take place on Sunday, July 17, for both parishes. 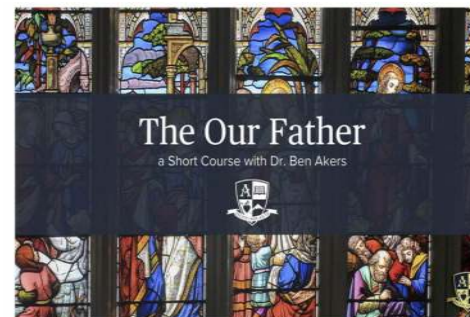

June 12, Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity: Prv 8:22-31 / Ps 8:4-5, 6-7, 8-9 / Rom 5:1-5 / Jn 16:12-15

There is so much behind a name. Despite the old jingle, "Sticks and stones may break my bones, but names will never hurt me," names matter, words matter, names are powerful, words are powerful—the Word made flesh—all powerful! As one of the priorities of our diocese to reclaim Sunday as the Lord's Day, we must not forget who the Lord of our life is and His name. The Lord's name is used more and more in our day, and age, as an expletive—"Oh, my G**!; J**** C****!" It should make our ears ring and our soul cringe. How do we reclaim the reverence of the Lord's name? We must use it reverently, lovingly—joyfully—and exclaim "O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth!" Perhaps, you have seen fellow Christians even bow their heads at the name of Jesus? Let's give it a try! It might even require us to lovingly remind others of the reverence in God's name. That might take heroic virtue, which may lead to affliction, and as St. Paul reminds us in his letter to the Romans, affliction produces hope, and "hope does not disappoint."
