# June 19, Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ: Gn 14:18-20 / Ps 110:1, 2, 3, 4 / 1 Cor 11:23-26 / Lk 9:11b-17

In today's Gospel, we find there are twelve baskets of bread leftover. Jesus turns five loaves of bread into enough for thousands. What did they do with all that leftover bread? Why was there so much bread leftover in the first place? Bread doesn't last that long in the open air. It gets hard, moldy, and being out in nature, it attracts all sorts of interested parties. Luke wrote that the bread put into the baskets were fragments, pieces leftover from what those who were present didn't eat. Obviously, they either had their fill or didn't care for the bread recipe. Looking back through the lens of Catholicity, we can see more than bread; we see substance—we see the foreshadowing of the Eucharist and the Eucharist cannot be wasted! Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. We may not have the answers to all the questions above, but we do have the answer, so rejoice in the truth, the source and summit of our faith!
