

Are you a "yes" man or woman? Always saying yes to every request for help, whether dire or not? It might feel easier to say yes for one reason or another. but after yes to this and yes to that, before long, the other end of that yes might be feeling like a burden. In the Diocese of Wichita, there are a plethora of opportunities to live out our mission of discipleship. However, after too many yeses, we may begin to feel like we are putting on the "yoke of slavery" as St. Paul writes to the Galatians in today's second reading. 


