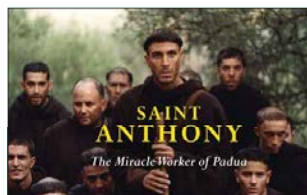

## BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10:00 a.m. Mass on either the first or second Sunday of the month at St. Anthony Parish and St. Mary Parish respectively when Fr. H. Setter is celebrating Mass. Parent(s) who plan to have their child baptized are required to be actively practicing their Catholic faith and be registered and active in the parish for no less than six months prior to the baptism. First time parent(s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the Parish Office during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

## MARRIAGES

The bride or groom must be registered in the parish for a minimum of six months before preparation for marriage will begin. The bride or groom registered in the parish is expected to be actively participating in the life of the Church by living the Stewardship Way of Life. Please contact the Pastor to begin. Dates for the weddings will only be scheduled AFTER meeting with the Pastor. Do not schedule, commit to, or make down payments for venues, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. until you have met with the Pastor. There is no guarantee to scheduling a wedding on your preferred day.

**Feast Day Celebration Update** - Reservations are now being taken for our upcoming Parish Feast Day Celebration on Sunday, June 12, 2022. You will find reservation cards at the ends of the pews in church. Please get these returned as soon as possible so we can plan accordingly. The deadline for returning your reservations is this Sunday, June 5. Please note that I must give the actual number attending to our caterer early Monday morning the 6<sup>th</sup>. Please do not wait until the last minute to make your reservations. Again, there will be no reservations made after June 5. I greatly appreciate your cooperation in advance.

**Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession** - As we celebrate the Year of the Eucharist, we will have a Eucharistic Procession on the Sunday of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, June 19. We will begin at 11:30 a.m. after the 10:00 a.m. Mass. We will process out of the church, around the hall parking lot into Biermann Street to Avenue B to Main Street, then back into the church. After a few minutes of adoration, we will conclude with Benediction. I have scheduled this event for 11:30 a.m. so people who do and do not want to attend the 10:00 a.m. Mass can all participate. As the Eucharist is at the center of our lives as Catholic Christians, I would strongly encourage as many as possible to participate in this beautiful expression of our love and belief in the Eucharist.

**Combined St. Anthony and St. Mary Year of the Eucharist 40 Hours Devotion** - As you know, our bishop has asked our parishes to add a 40 Hours celebration to our year of the Eucharist events. Our 40 hours will take place on Sunday, July 17, for both parishes. We will begin our celebration with a brunch in the St. Anthony Parish Hall at 11:15 a.m. and then begin exposition at 12:30 p.m. in St. Anthony Church. Sign up opportunities will soon be available.

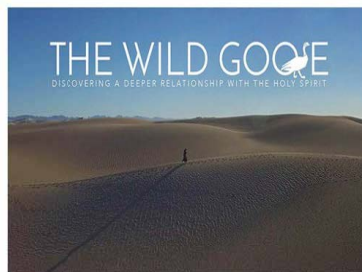
