## *Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity*

JUNE 12, 2022

Proverbs 8:22-31; Romans 5:1-5;  
John 16:12-15

From all eternity, there is only one God. From all eternity, there are Three Persons in this one God: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. As far as their attributes, whatever can be said of the Father, can also be said of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

The Father is eternal, almighty, infinite in perfection; so also is the Son; so also is the Holy Spirit. But there are not three “almighties” or three “eternals,” but only one almighty, eternal God infinite in perfection. The Father is not the Son is not the Holy Spirit. They are distinct Persons who share and completely possess the one nature of God.

From all eternity, the Father begets the Son; from all eternity, the Son is born of the Father. From all eternity, the Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father and the Son. (The Oriental Churches express this as “from the Father through the Son.”)

In time, about 7 B.C., only the Son became incarnate: The Word was made flesh. The Second Person of the Trinity became fully man without ceasing to be God. Jesus Christ is equal to the Father in his divinity, but less than the Father in his humanity: But he is One Person, ever to be adored in his majesty.

All of this is very heady theology! In fact, absolutely nothing is known of the Trinity in the Old Testament. Only Jesus reveals to us this central mystery of our faith. He revealed it as the practical basis of our spiritual life.

The Father loves us with an everlasting love; yet, in the Old Testament, he seems clouded in unapproachable light. We can scarcely visualize him as a Person. He seems so far above us.

The Eternal Son of God became man to show us the Father. When we see Jesus, we see the love of the Father. He is one of us. He is our access to the Father, our Mediator, our Savior. He assures us of the Father's forgiveness. He is the model of what God intended us to be. He gave his life for us. In him, we can have confidence in approaching the Father.

But we no longer see Jesus; he has returned to the glory of the Father. He has not left us orphans, however. He has sent the Holy Spirit, the “Paraclete.” “Paraclete” means “one who stands by.” He stands by us as our advocate, as our defense attorney against all the trials of this earth. He stands by us to comfort us and strengthen us. He stands by us to make us one in Christ Jesus. He manifests the Son to us, just as the Son manifested the Father.

In the Holy Spirit, we are joined with Mary and all the saints in Christ. Our spiritual life, then, must be rooted in the mystery of the Trinity. We give glory TO the Father, THROUGH the Son, IN the Holy Spirit, WITH the Blessed Virgin Mary and all the saints! Let us live and pray as we profess to believe.

# The Most Holy Trinity

This weekend is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. One God, Three Persons — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. This communal life of God is witnessed in the readings this weekend. Wisdom in Proverbs is speaking about how she never changes and always is. Big T, Truth, is eternal and never changing. We see the world around us wrapped in relativism of you believe whatever you want, and I will believe whatever I want. You have your truth and I have my truth. Constantly throughout history people have been seeking truth. The philosophers have been posing this question for ages. Pilate even asks Jesus, “What is truth?” Wisdom and Truth are eternal and of God. Come to know the will and mind of God and the truth is evident and revealed to us in His Church and Scripture. We should strive always to remain in union with the Church and allow the Lord's will to become more and more our own to have a greater and greater understanding of Truth...and of Him. This Trinity Sunday, be enveloped in the Trinity. This Trinity Sunday, see the communal nature of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and be wrapped in the grace of God in His Church.

This past week I had COVID for a second time, which is why you saw me at none of the Masses this weekend. I missed you all this weekend. Strangely enough, I was quite sick this second time through. I did not therefore get to attend the retreat and instead stayed home to quarantine. Please know of my gratitude for many who found out and took care of me this week bringing me food and medicines. Next week is Corpus Christi Sunday where we commemorate the gift of the Most Holy Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. As we look forward to this Eucharistic Revival we are doing nationally and locally in the Diocese of Springfield in IL., we will kick this revival off with this procession. ## Stewardship Bulletin Reflection

June 12, 2022 — The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

PRV 8:22-31; PS 8: 4-9; ROM 5:1-5; JN 16: 12-15

Today we celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Trinity. What we are commemorating is a central reality of our Christian faith, that God is Trinitarian in nature — three distinct persons in one God.

The Church calls this truth a mystery, as indeed it is. Some have said that “mystery” in this context is “not a wall to run up against but an ocean in which to swim.” Contemplating the “ocean depths” of this mystery can make us humans feel so small, and almighty God so far from us. Yet nothing could be further from the truth as today’s readings demonstrate.

In the second reading, St. Paul reminds us that God is intimately connected to us. “The love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us.” God wants live in the very depths of our being and in all the intimate details of our lives if we will let Him.

And in the Gospel from St. John, we learn that God holds back nothing of Himself from us. Jesus tells His disciples (this includes us!) that the Holy Spirit “will take from what is mine and declare it to you. Everything the Father has is mine.” Thus, we find ourselves drawn right into the midst of this Trinitarian love. In fact, if the mystery of Holy Trinity is an ocean which to swim, the “water” that makes up that ocean is love.

What then should be the response of the Christian steward to this sublime mystery? All we can do is worship. And offer our lives back to God in total gratitude for calling us to live in the richness of such unfathomable love.

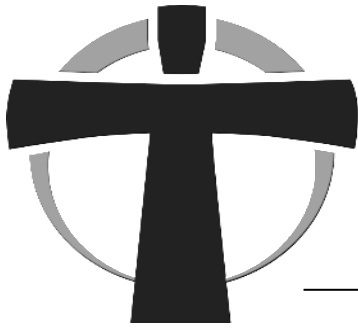
