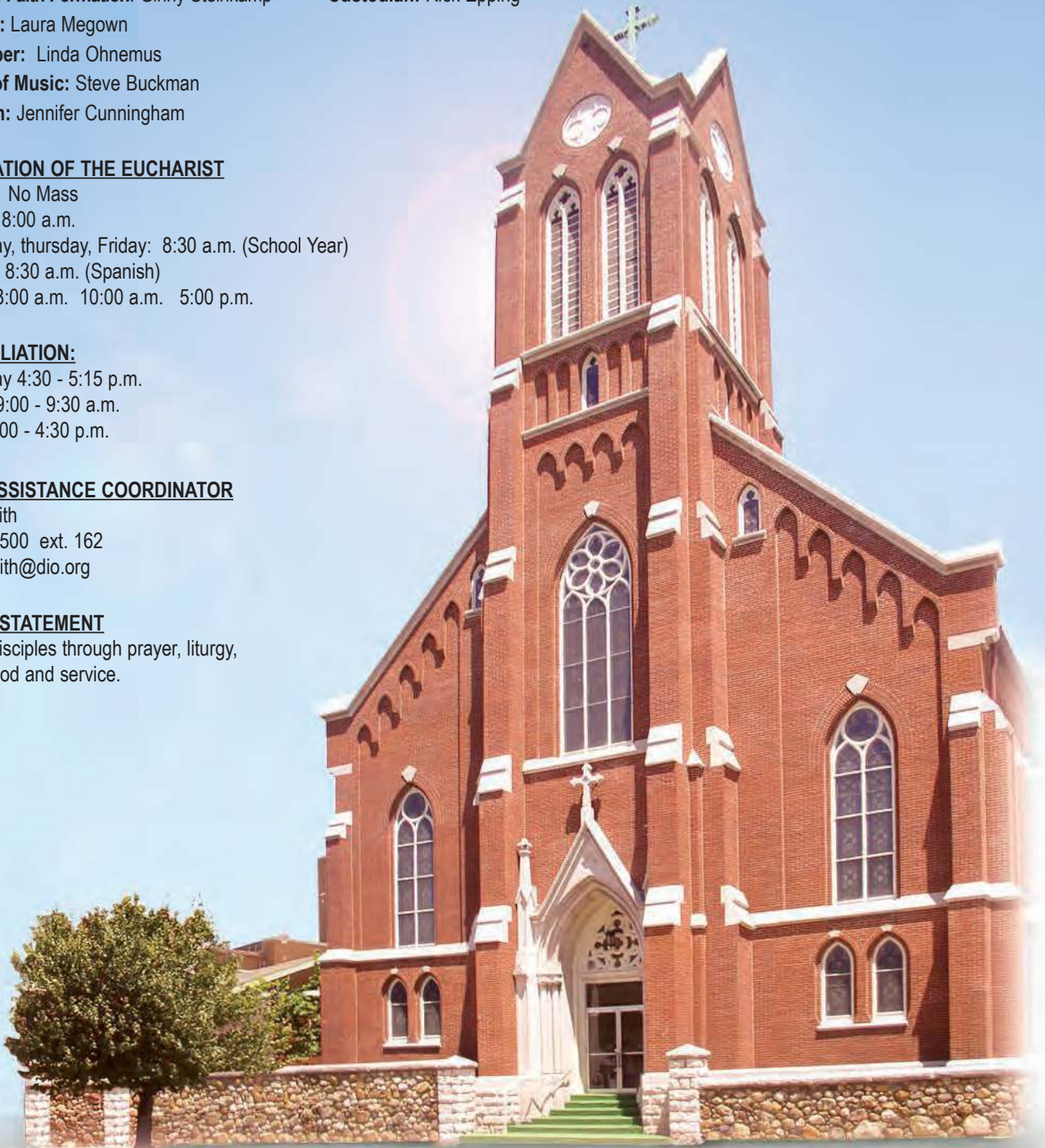

Today we celebrate the 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time. In the gospel story we hear the **Parable of the Rich Fool**. The rich man has so much in abundance that he chooses to tear down his barns and build larger ones. Jesus tells us, "Take care to guard against all greed, for though one may be rich, one's life does not consist of possessions." We often compare our own wellbeing with the material wellbeing of others. This can become a source of personal unhappiness and resentment. Happiness comes not in building riches, but in building friendships that are rich in meaning.

Finally, it is time to begin thinking about **RCIA**. In a few weeks we will begin our next season of weekly RCIA sessions for those considering entrance into the Catholic faith. The first several months of RCIA are considered a period of "Inquiry" when participants have a chance to learn more about the Catholic faith without making any specific commitments. Hospitality Team

Catechetical Programming Team

Are you a bit of a Catholic nerd? Do you love to crack open a good papal document? Are you passionate about the study of Scripture and lives of the Saints? Our Catechetical team will work to understand what topics parents are looking for more formation on. Additionally, they will plan parents’ Bible studies to allow for more opportunities throughout the year. They will give feedback on family faith formation is generally going.

Prayer Warriors

Satan hates the family and seeks to sow seeds of disunity among its members. Our prayer warriors will pray for the intentions of the Domestic Church Circle and offer sacrifices. **We need one coordinator of the Prayer Warriors to send out the monthly intentions.**

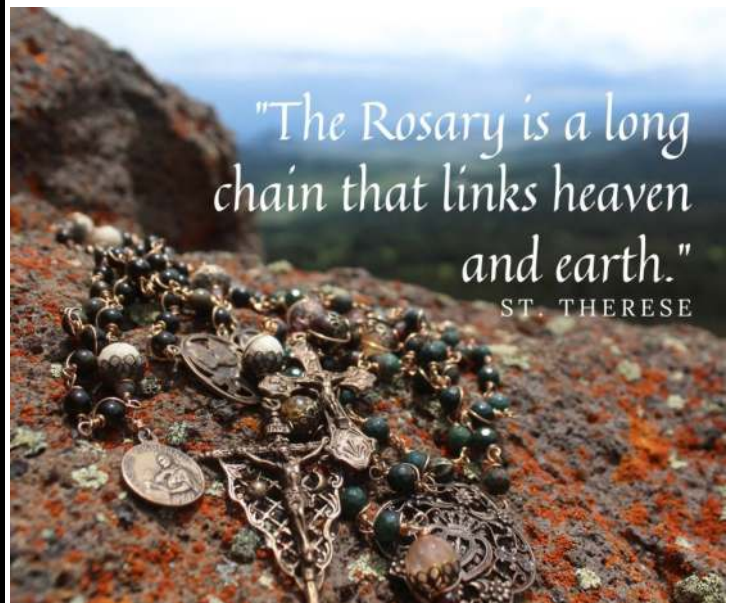
