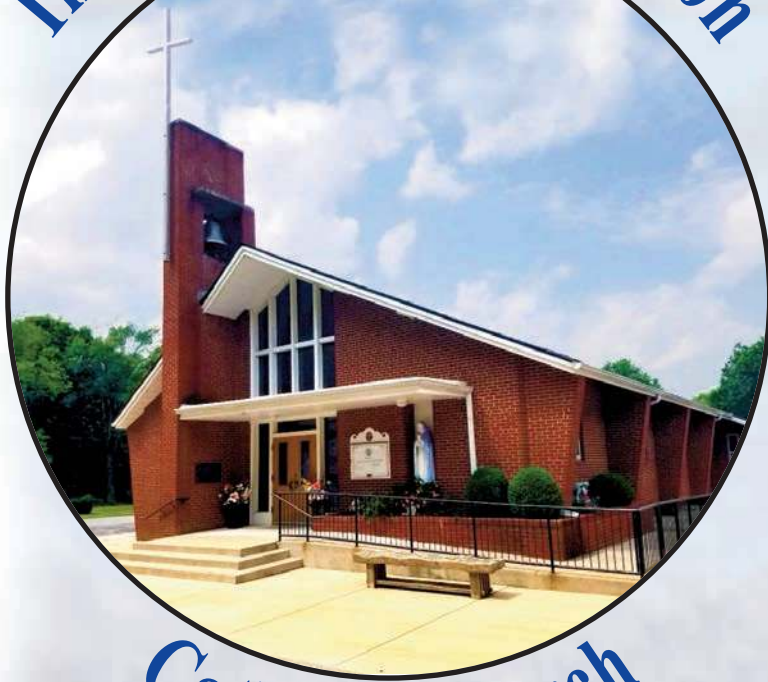

The overturning of Roe vs. Wade was news for which we have waited and prayed. Praise be to God! While we can rejoice, remember what we are facing in Kansas that in fact makes the passage of Value Them Both even more important! Kansas is key to the abortion industry's Post-Roe strategy.

A Kansas Supreme Court's 2019 ruling resulted in Kansas being a destination for abortion because of a lawsuit brought by the New York-based Center for Reproductive Rights (CRR). CRR told the *Washington Post* that Kansas was being set up as a "haven" state for abortion. Since 2019, Kansas has seen a 16% increase in out-of-state travel here for abortion. Even the *Kansas City Star* confirmed that we could see a 1000%+ increase in abortions if we do not pass the Value Them Both Amendment.
