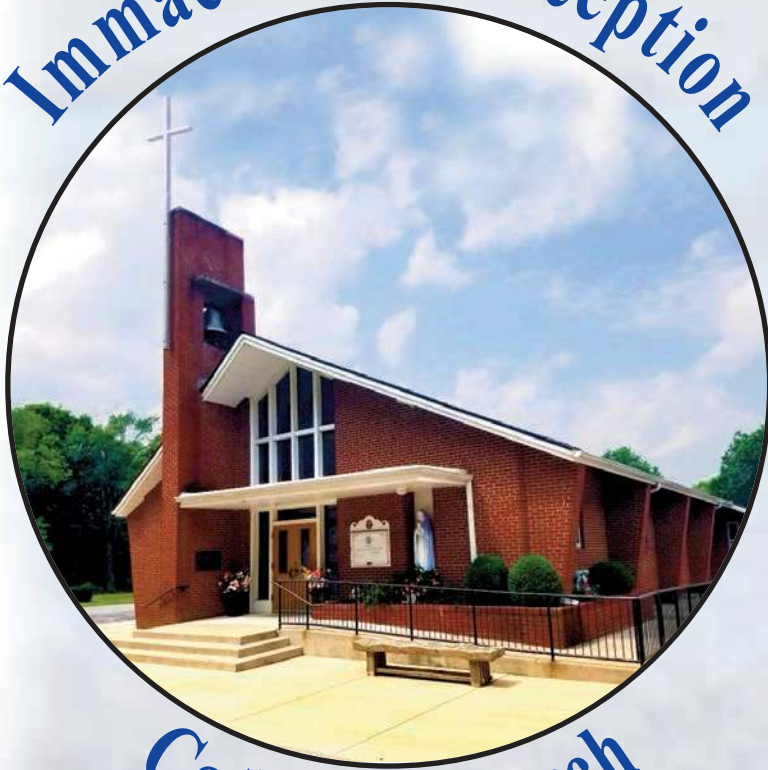

Value Them Both – Clarifying Misinformation: There has been much misinformation coming from ads opposing the Value Them Both (VTB) Amendment. This causes confusion around sensitive and important topics. The opposition claims that if VTB passes, women will not be able to receive medical treatment for miscarriages or other life-threatening situations such as ectopic pregnancies or other pregnancy complications. This simply is not true. Medical treatments for ectopic pregnancies, miscarriages and other pregnancy complications are not the same as an abortion. In addition, reputable physicians who treat high-risk pregnancies will say abortion is not medically necessary to treat or save the life of the mother.
