



#### BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10:00 a.m. Mass on either the first or second Sunday of the month at St. Anthony Parish and St. Mary Parish respectively when Fr. H. Setter is celebrating Mass. Parent(s) who plan to have their child baptized are required to be actively practicing their Catholic faith and be registered and active in the parish for no less than six months prior to the baptism. First time parent(s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the Parish Office during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

#### MARRIAGES

The bride or groom must be registered in the parish for a minimum of six months before preparation for marriage will begin. The bride or groom registered in the parish is expected to be actively participating in the life of the Church by living the Stewardship Way of Life. Please contact the Pastor to begin. Dates for the weddings will only be scheduled AFTER meeting with the Pastor. Do not schedule, commit to, or make down payments for venues, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. until you have met with the Pastor. There is no guarantee to scheduling a wedding on your preferred day.

**July 10, Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time: Dt 30:10-14 / Ps 69:14, 17, 30-31, 33-34, 36,37 / Col 1:15-20 / Lk 10:25-37**

The most recent Andover tornado was rather selective in its destruction it left behind. Where one house stood untouched, its neighbor was leveled. There was a great outpouring of support and effort to assist those that were affected by the tornado. Jesus shares with us the parable of the Good Samaritan in today's Gospel. The robbers were selective in their victim. It doesn't say much about the victim other than that he was a man. We all have neighbors — do you know your neighbor? A lot of people got to know their neighbors during the tornado cleanup. The Samaritan probably got to know his neighbor that he helped after the robbers were done with him. The inn keeper probably got to know the victimized man, too. The priest and the Levite missed their chance. They saw, assessed, and abandoned their neighbor. Being a missionary disciple requires us to get outside our reactive mode and into our proactive mode. There will always be tragedies on this side of heaven, but we can avoid the one of not knowing our neighbor.
