

#### A Message from Fr. Tom Donovan:



**St. Anthony Picnic**: Welcome, one-and-all, to the 2022 St. Anthony Picnic! Thank you to the many who have volunteered or have contributed to this festival to make it a success! While the picnic is a major fundraiser for the parish and school, first and foremost, it is a celebration of our parish family, which some century-and-a-half later is still enjoying dinner and a beer together near the creek. Welcome to all the friends and neighbors who join us, and thank you for your continued support of St. Anthony Parish and St. Dominic School!



Martha and Mary: Last week we heard the Gospel of the "Good Samaritan," in which we heard that mercy and Christian charity looks like *something...* it is an active involvement with the needs and concerns of others over one's self. Immediately after that parable, the Gospel presents the event of Jesus coming to the house of Martha and Mary and Lazarus, where Martha gets called out for being "concerned about many things," not the least of which is the rightfully-important duty of hospitality to guests. Jesus tells us

through them however, that His followers are more than busy-bodies. Christianity is certainly a "doing" faith, but it is also a "being" faith, taking the time to rest in the words and the wisdom of the Lord. A "doer" in the name of Christ who does not nurture the inner life can find themselves lost from the true center of our faith, which is Jesus Christ himself. And so, while Martha and Mary both have a privileged relationship with our Lord, we learn that Mary has chosen the better part.



**Anointing of the Sick:** On the weekend of August 6 and 7, we will offer the Anointing of the Sick at all of the weekend Masses. Those who have a serious illness, an upcoming surgery, or are "weighted down by the burden of years" are encouraged to sit in the front row that weekend to receive the sacrament along with the prayers of our parish community. If you have a family member or friend who is unable to attend Mass on a regular basis, we encourage you to make a special effort to help that person come to Mass that weekend and receive the Anointing.

The sacrament is, of course, offered at other times by calling the Parish Office or, if you are in Blessing Hospital or another health facility, by letting

your nurse or chaplain know. We encourage all who anticipate needing the sacrament to ask for it in advance, in a timely way if at all possible, to minimize emergency calls and, at times, to help arrange proper permissions to access health facilities which are still on "COVID lockdowns."

Mass is offered each week by St. Anthony Parish at Good Samaritan Home at 10 a.m. on Thursdays. We are always in need of volunteers who can come to Mass and help transport the residents to the chapel and back. Please contact the parish office, 222-5996, for more information about this opportunity to help our nursing home residents celebrate the sacraments! An Anointing Mass for all residents will be held at Good Samaritan Home at 10 a.m. on Thursday, August 3.


