Isaiah 66:18-21. Psalm 117:1, 2.  
Hebrews 12:5-7, 11-13. Luke 13:22-30.

**Are Only a Few to Be Saved?** It is not uncommon for someone to ask us: "Have you been saved?" Often, they are looking for one fixed date, one specific event. But we know these truths: (1) We are saved everyday - because of God's grace; (2) God chooses to save everyone - me and them; (3) Salvation is strengthened by working for justice, by living merciful lives.

How will I acknowledge that I am being saved by Christ **every** day?

## *Our Church History*

To the right of Mary is the statue of St. Rose of Lima. Rose was born in Lima, Peru in 1586. She led a virtuous life at home, and after receiving the habit of the Third Order of St. Dominic, she progressed in a life of penance, meditation, and prayer. She died August 24, 1617, at age 31. Her feast day is August 23. She is the patron saint of embroiders, gardeners, florist, people who are harassed for their piety, and those suffering family problems.
