

To the right of Mary is the statue of St. Rose of Lima. Rose was born in Lima, Peru in 1586. She led a virtuous life at home, and after receiving the habit of the Third Order of St. Dominic, she progressed in a life of penance, meditation, and prayer. She died August 24, 1617, at age 31. Her feast day is August 23. She is the patron saint of embroiders, gardeners, florist, people who are harassed for their piety, and those suffering family problems.




