

#### Saturday 4:30 p.m. Mass Sunday 5:00 p.m. Mass



St. Teresa of Avila was born in Avila, Spain in 1515. She joined the Carmelite Order, made great progress in the way of perfection, and enjoyed mystical revelations. When she reformed the Order, she met with much resistance, but she succeeded with undaunted courage. She also wrote books filled sublime doctrine, the fruit of her own spiritual life. For that reason, she is depicted holding a book and quill pen. She died in 1587. Her feast day is October 15. She is the Patron Saint of Missions.




