

"If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you." We all wish we had faith this strong. We have many helpful tools to build up our faith - the Eucharist, Daily Prayer, Daily Scripture, Regular Confession, and works of charity. Like physical exercise strengthens the body, these spiritual gifts strengthen our faith. What is the Lord calling me to place into my routine today to grow my faith.

This weekend our parish Finance Council is presenting the Annual Financial Report for Fiscal Year 2021-22. Members of the Finance Council are making a brief presentation at each of our Sunday Masses. We thank the Finance Council for their good work in overseeing the financial operations of our parish.

Today is Respect Life Sunday. Today the Church celebrates Respect for all Human Life from conception until natural death. Sins that are contrary to basic human dignity include murder, abortion, embryonic stem-cell research and cloning, euthanasia and physician-assisted suicide, and the death penalty. Bishop Paprocki and our U.S. bishops point out that for American voters there are many important issues that require our attention at election time; however abortion is the preeminent issue. May we continue to defend the dignity of all human life.

This month we begin our October Count of all persons attending Mass on the weekends of October. These numbers assist the Springfield Diocese in their continued efforts of

pastoral planning.

Next Sunday we will hear our annual Lay Witness Talk from **Donna Vogel**, in preparation for our annual Stewardship Sunday (October 23). We thank our parish members for their courage and witness that inspire us in our own journey of discipleship and stewardship.

- Wednesday, October 12, 5:30 p.m.: Respect Life Mass. Throughout the day (8:30-5:00 p.m.) Eucharistic Adoration will be offered for the Special Intention of Respect for all Human Life. Parish members and parish groups are encouraged to spend 30 minutes or an hour in prayer sometime throughout the day. At 5:30 p.m. we will have Mass with the special intention of praying for Respect and Defense of all Human Life.
- Tuesday, October 18, 6:00 p.m.: Health Care Mass. Traditionally known as the White Mass, this Mass is celebrated to honor doctors, nurses, medical technicians, hospital administrators, and emergency personnel in appreciation for their service to the local community. This Mass will be a wonderful opportunity for our parish community to thank the members of our Healthcare community for the tremendous work they have done throughout these many months since the start of the COVID pandemic.

Beginning this weekend, as a means to concluding the discussion on which Weekend Evening (Saturday or Sunday) should be the parish's weekend evening Mass, we are going to have an official "Vote with our Feet." For 8 weeks (Saturday, October 1 to Sunday, November 20), we are going to celebrate both Weekend Masses and count the attendance at both of these Masses:

### Saturday, 4:30 p.m. Mass Sunday, 5:00 p.m. Mass

At the end of those 8 weeks, the Mass with the highest Mass count will become the parish's weekend evening Mass. The First Sunday of Advent (November 26-27) will have in place the Mass schedule of whatever has been chosen. Thank you to all the ministers who will be putting in extra work for these 8 weeks of 4-Mass weekends. Your time and help is very much appreciated.

Finally, please mark your calendars for "Quincy Holy Family Fest" which will take place on Saturday, October 22, at the Quincy Knights of Columbus. Please see our bulletin for more details about this family-friendly way to grow in our Catholic faith.
