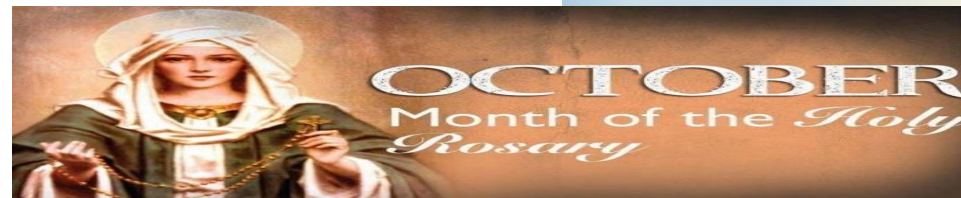

### BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10:00 a.m. Mass on either the first or second Sunday of the month at St. Anthony Parish and St. Mary Parish respectively when Fr. H. Setter is celebrating Mass. Parent(s) who plan to have their child baptized are required to be actively practicing their Catholic faith and be registered and active in the parish for no less than six months prior to the baptism. First time parent(s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the Parish Office during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

### MARRIAGES

The bride or groom must be registered in the parish for a minimum of six months before preparation for marriage will begin. The bride or groom registered in the parish is expected to be actively participating in the life of the Church by living the Stewardship Way of Life. Please contact the Pastor to begin. Dates for the weddings will only be scheduled **AFTER** meeting with the Pastor. Do not schedule, commit to, or make down payments for venues, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. until you have met with the Pastor. There is no guarantee to scheduling a wedding on your preferred day.

**Tootsie Roll Drive** - will be October 8 and 9 after all Masses.

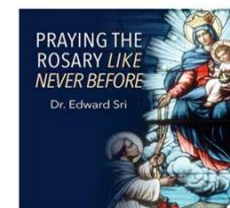

**October 2, Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time: Hab 1:2-3, 2:2-4 / Ps 95:1-2, 6-7, 8-9 / 2 Tm 1:6-8, 13-14 / Lk 17:5-10**

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I know I am small, and used sparingly in recipes, and thought little of relative to Creation. However, God created me, as He did you, as part of His masterful plan. In today's Gospel, our dear Lord refers to me in a way that has created a bit of confusion, perhaps even disbelief. The Apostles demanded Jesus to "Increase our faith." Since then, I've been consulted by many — "How do I get as much faith as you?" My answer is always the same. Faith, like me, needs to be nurtured, cared for, and attended to, or it can quickly become forgotten. I don't try to be an appleseed or a bumblebee, I respond as a mustard seed and I bear the fruit of a mustard seed. If you, too, respond as a disciple of Jesus, you will bear the fruit of a disciple of Jesus.
