

October 2, Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time: Hab 1:2-3, 2:2-4 / Ps 95:1-2, 6-7, 8-9 / 2 Tm 1:6-8, 13-14 / Lk 17:5-10

Dear Brothers and Sisters,


