FROM THE RECTOR – Fifteenth Sunday after Pentecost

The exhortation of St. Paul to the Galatians reminds us of the need to walk with and live with the Spirit. While this is a simple statement the requirement for those who hear it is a reliance upon the virtue of courage. The Holy Spirit holds and binds us together, safeguards the Church from enemies without and within, and enlivens our minds, hearts and souls to be responsive to the Incarnate Word. What is required from us is trust and confidence in the Holy Spirit. We ask for inspiration and guidance and the Lord hears our prayers; however, the answer may often come in ways we least expect or fail to recognize at all. To become attuned to the workings of God requires trust and confidence and these on a daily basis. What St. Paul recommends is the practice of humility, distrusting ourselves and placing all our trust in the Lord. Be open to those realities that will humble you and rely not upon yourself but trust only in the Lord.
