

Let us pray for insight. May we see around us the ones who seem invisible in their needs, and may we respond to those needs from our own excess.



Reflecting on today's readings, one might feel a sense of urgency. It is so easy, once in a comfortable state, to stay there and enjoy the moment. Moments can add up quickly, and pretty soon comfort begets leisure, and leisure begets lifestyle, and lifestyle begets haughtiness, and there before us, is a chasm, between ourselves and the poor beggar, Lazarus, in today's Gospel.
