



## Our Church History

St. Bernard of Clairvaux was born in 1090 near Dijon, France. After a religious upbringing he joined the Cistercian Order in 1111 and later was chosen abbot of the monastery of Clairvaux. Here, he directed his companions in the practice of virtue by his own good example.

He wrote many theological and spiritual works. He died in 1153 and his feast day is August 20. Our statue shows Bernard wearing his Cistercian habit with a cross around his neck as abbot. An interesting detail is the beehive located under his feet. He is the Patron Saint of Beekeepers.




