BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10:00 a.m. Mass on either the first or second Sunday of the month at St. Anthony Parish and St. Mary Parish respectively when Fr. H. Setter is celebrating Mass. Parent(s) who plan to have their child baptized are required to be actively practicing their Catholic faith and be registered and active in the parish for no less than six months prior to the baptism. First time parent(s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the Parish Office during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

MARRIAGES

The bride or groom must be registered in the parish for a minimum of six months before preparation for marriage will begin. The bride or groom registered in the parish is expected to be actively participating in the life of the Church by living the Stewardship Way of Life. Please contact the Pastor to begin. Dates for the weddings will only be scheduled **AFTER** meeting with the Pastor. Do not schedule, commit to, or make down payments for venues, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. until you have met with the Pastor. There is no guarantee to scheduling a wedding on your preferred day.

September 11, Twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time: Ex 32:7-11, 13-14 / Ps 51:3-4, 12-13, 17, 19 / 1 Tm 1:12-17 / Lk 15:1-32

"Coming to his senses he thought"...the prodigal son thus began the road back to the loving arms of his father. How did he come to his senses? Would he have come to his senses if he had not yet blown his inheritance? Maybe, maybe not. We've heard a lot of conversion stories like the prodigal son. Then there is the story of the prodigal son's brother. He may not have been drifting away physically, but his heart was not moving towards his father. We should rejoice at the repentance of our brothers and sisters, even though it is hard at times when they have gone away, and we have stayed. So, are we trying to please the Father exteriorly? Are we avoiding going on mission to bring back our fellow children of God? Following Moses' example, we must go out after our lost and implore God's mercy on their behalf. If not, we may find ourselves in the prodigal brother's shoes — angry, ungrateful, and interiorly drifting. Bringing our brothers and sisters back to God keeps us close to God.

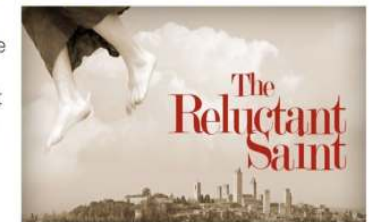
