BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10:00 a.m. Mass on either the first or second Sunday of the month at St. Anthony Parish and St. Mary Parish respectively when Fr. H. Setter is celebrating Mass. Parent(s) who plan to have their child baptized are required to be actively practicing their Catholic faith and be registered and active in the parish for no less than six months prior to the baptism. First time parent(s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the Parish Office during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

MARRIAGES

The bride or groom must be registered in the parish for a minimum of six months before preparation for marriage will begin. The bride or groom registered in the parish is expected to be actively participating in the life of the Church by living the Stewardship Way of Life. Please contact the Pastor to begin. Dates for the weddings will only be scheduled **AFTER** meeting with the Pastor. Do not schedule, commit to, or make down payments for venues, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. until you have met with the Pastor. There is no guarantee to scheduling a wedding on your preferred day.

September 4, Twenty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time: Wis 9:13-18b / Ps 90:3-4,5-6,12-13, 14 and 17 / Phmn 9-10, 12-17 / Lk 14:25-33

"Who can know God's counsel, or who can conceive what the LORD intends?" In today's Gospel, Jesus counsels us on the three obstacles to discipleship: relationships with our neighbor, ourselves, and our stuff. None of these can get in the way of following Jesus, but all three of these relationships can assist us in becoming missionary disciples. First, Jesus tells us we must hate our neighbor to be His disciple. Boy, does that sound contrary to the Gospel. We might ask ourselves—who in my life do I put ahead of our Lord? Then He shared with us how we must carry our own crosses and follow Him. What cross(es) have I not embraced? Or, am I carrying someone else's cross—a cross too many? Lastly, we are to renounce all our possessions. Think time, talent, and treasure, and try to give it, live it, and share it!
